CAS Champions

The Network has worked with Health Boards to identify CEN CAS Champions. CAS Champions are individuals who are the main Health Board link for CEN CAS data. An example of the benefits of the CAS Champions role would be, on the rare occasion that a Neonatologist or general acute paediatrician in a Board is caring for a baby who meets, or is predicted to continue to meet, the CEN criteria, they could contact the local CAS Champion who can assist by entering the child's details onto CAS. This will help to save a delay in recording the child as having exceptional healthcare needs as not all senior paediatricians have access to the CAS system. The Champions' role will solely be around the administrative side of the process not the clinical decision making.
